Wiltshire & Swindon Minerals & Waste Policies

In accordance with the above Regulations (specifically Regulation 28), the County and Borough Councils have formally submitted the following development plan documents to the Secretary of State for the purposes of commencing the independent examination:

- Wiltshire and Swindon Waste Development Control Policies – Submission Draft Document: July 2008; and
- Wiltshire and Swindon Minerals Development Control Policies – Submission Draft Document: July 2008.

There will now follow a final period of public consultation **commencing Monday 4th August and closing Friday 12th September 2008**. The purpose of this final round of consultation will be to test the overall 'soundness' of the submitted Minerals and Waste Development Control Policies. To be considered as 'duly made', all representations must be submitted by **5.00pm 12th September 2008**. Any representations received after that date may not be passed to the appointed Planning Inspector for consideration during the examination process.

To support the submission documents, the County and Borough Councils have prepared a detailed Evidence Base, Statements of Consultation, Sustainability Appraisal (SA) Reports, Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA) Reports and a Strategic Flood Risk Assessment (SFRA).

Copies of **all** documents submitted to the Secretary of State and published for consultation are (including the Councils' Statements of Consultation) available to view or download on the County Council's website: www.wiltshire.gov.uk/planning-home. They are also available for inspection at the Offices of the County, Borough and District Councils as well as all libraries in Wiltshire and Swindon.
